

Hey Cavaliers!

Are you living in any of the following situations?

- Hotel or campground due to the lack of an alternative adequate accommodation.
- In a car, park, abandoned building, or bus or train station.
- Doubled up with other people due to loss of housing or economic hardship.

You may qualify for certain rights and protections under the federal McKinney-Vento Act.

Eligible students have the right to:

- Receive a free, appropriate public education.
- Enroll in school immediately, even if lacking documents normally required for enrollment.
- Enroll in school and attend classes while the school gathers necessary documents.
- Enroll in local school; or continued attending their school of origin, if that is their preference.
- Receive transportation to and from the school of origin, if requested.
- Receive education services comparable to those provided to other students according to their needs.
